Playing rules for 180 Over and Under Tournament

1. All USBC rules shall apply.
2. **Eligibility:** Bowlers must hold a current Greater Bloomington USBC membership card. If you have an average of 190 or higher this season (2009-2010) after 21 games, you must bowl as an "over" bowler only.
3. **Entering Average:** You must use highest 2008 -09 average unless you are 10 pins higher this season as of March 1, with at least 21 games bowled. USBC rule 319a-2 and rule 319a-3 will apply to all bowlers who incorrectly report average. If no USBC average from 2008-09 season use, current season's highest average of 21 games or more will be used. In accordance with USBC rule 319b, all others will bowl scratch. Membership cards may be asked to be seen before bowling. Bowlers shall be allowed 48 hours from completion of their squad to adjust or prove average.
4. **Rerating:** USBC rule 319d, any bowler who has won a prize of \$300 or more in any tournament within the last 12 months must report same to the Tournament Manager at time of check-in and rule 319e will apply.
5. **Handicap:** Will be based on 90% of the bowlers' average from 210.
6. **Participation:** tournament is a doubles format with one bowler having an average of 180 or less and one bowler having an average of 181 or higher. Bowlers may enter as many times as they wish, cash only once with same partner.
7. **Entry Fee:** Paid at the time of bowling.
8. **Closing date** will be at the time of last squad.
9. **Check-in time** will be ½ hour prior to scheduled squad. Any late arrivals will begin bowling in current frame, with a zero given for all frames missed.
10. **Ties:** In the event of a tie, the monies will be combined and evenly divided.
11. The Tournament Manager has supervisory control of all technical parts of the Tournament. All decisions by the Tournament Manager will be final unless an appeal is made in accordance to rule 329.
