Tournament Rules

1. This tournament is sanctioned and therefore any rules that are not covered below, USBC Rules will apply.
2. Participation is open to all members of the Greater Bloomington USBC and anyone residing within the jurisdiction of the Greater Bloomington USBC. Eligible participants that are not a member of the Greater Bloomington USBC can qualify for participation by purchasing an affiliate membership for \$17.00.
3. Re-entries will be accepted, depending on availability. Only the highest score will be accepted. The tournament format will be as follows:

SATURDAY Jan 30th

- a. Bowlers will bowl 4 games of qualifying (all scores will be scratch) at either 1 pm or 3:15 pm
- b. The field will then be cut to the top 8 scores for match play on Sunday
- c. In the event of a tie for 8th place, a one game roll-off will determine 8th place
- d. In the event of a tie at the end of the roll-off game, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will determine the 8th place
- e. In the event of a tie at the end of the 9th and 10th frame roll-off, a sudden death best ball will determine the 8th place

SUNDAY Jan 31st

- f. Match play will consist of single elimination bracket play
- g. Seeding of the Bracket will be based on qualifying scores from Saturday
- h. 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, 3 vs. 6, and 4 vs. 5
- i. 2 game matches with total pins determining the winner of the match (all scores will be scratch)
- j. In the event of a tie at the end of the 2 game match a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will determine the winner.
- k. In the event of a tie after the 9th and 10th frame roll-off, a sudden death best ball will determine the winner.

4. Entry Closing Date January 30th at 3:15pm
5. Entry Fee is \$45.00. Checks should be made payable to the Greater Bloomington USBC.
6. Checks: The Greater Bloomington USBC accepts checks under the following condition: **ANY CHECK RETURNED TO THE GREATER BLOOMINGTON USBC FOR ANY REASON WILL BE SUBJECT TO A \$25.00 SERVICE FEE.**
7. Late arrivals will start in the frame being bowled with zero score for the missed frames
8. The Tournament Management has supervisory control of all technical parts of the operations of the tournament (RULE 303). All decisions of the Tournament Management shall be final except where an appeal is made to the USBC for further consideration (RULE 329)
