Category (Select One)

___ Outstanding Performance

This is to honor men and women who have contributed to the growth and welfare of the sport of bowling through their service and achievements in the adult division Greater Bloomington USBC or predecessor associations. To be eligible for this honor the nominee must be or have been a member of the Greater Bloomington USBC for a minimum of fifteen (15) years and must have bowled in at least 10 local association tournaments. The only exception that will be given to a candidate is if their career has been shortened due to illness or injury. The candidate's performance shall be superior to other bowlers.

___ Meritorious Service

Dedication to the sport of bowling within the Greater Bloomington Bowling USBC or predecessor associations. Such contribution must include participation in and as member of the adult division of the ABC, WIBC or USBC member for at least fifteen years (15). Other accomplishment shall include but not be limited to league officer, association director, association officer, bowling accomplishments, leadership coaching and training to the junior bowling association, state and national officers, state and national voting delegates, participating in state and national tournaments, etc. The candidate must also demonstrate outstanding leadership and sportsmanship.

___ Dedication to the Sport of Bowling

Meritorious contribution to the sport of bowling within the Greater Bloomington Bowling USBC for a minimum period of fifteen (15) years. Such contribution may include but not limited to sponsorship of leagues, teams, or contributions to the Greater Bloomington annual tournaments in the form of financial or merchandise contributions. The Hall of Fame Selection Committee shall make the determination as to whether or not a nominee's contribution has been significant enough to warrant consideration.
