1. Eligibility: a) Must be at least 50 years of age as of the date of participation
b) Must be a current member of the Greater Bloomington USBC
Required to show USBC Membership card or receipt.
2. Competition will be in five classes Class E – 50-59 years of age; Class D – 60-64 years of age; Class C – 65-69 years of age; Class B – 70-79 years of age and Class A – 80 years of age and over.
3. Handicap will be based on the bowler's highest sanctioned league average for 21 or more games during the 2008/2009 season. When there is no established average, bowlers may use their sanctioned summer league average of 21 or more games. BOWLERS HAVING NO 2008/09 AVERAGE WILL USE THEIR CURRENT SANCTIONED AVERAGE OF 12 OR MORE GAMES AT THE TIME OF PARTICIPATION. Bowlers who have no 2008/09 average or current average of 12 or more games: Men will use 175 and women will use 140. (USBC Rule 319b.) Winner's averages will be verified.
4. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average; if higher, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
5. Bowlers who are subject to re-rating under the provisions of USBC Rule 319c. will be required to follow the procedure in that rule.
6. USBC Rules 319a.2, 319d and 319e are waived.
7. Corrections in averages can be made prior to the completion of the first game.
8. A bowler may participate only once.
9. Bowlers who are not USBC Members may enter by purchasing the affiliate membership in the amount of \$17.00. Membership in a senior league is not required.
10. All prize fees will be returned 100% in cash for both men and women. One in five entries will cash.
11. In the event of a tie for first place, co-champions will be declared. Prize money will be combined and divided equally in the event of a tie for any position.
12. A bowler who misses one frame or more by not being present and ready to bowl when it is their turn shall not be credited with any pins for frames missed.
